Revenue for the year ended December 31, 2015 is expected to be \$4,888,302 compared to \$719,267 for the year ended December 31, 2014. The increase is primarily due to \$4,000,000 received from the sale of two patent families in 2015. The net loss for the year ended December 31, 2014 was \$20,521,470. The net loss for the year ended December 31, 2015 will be finalized upon completion of the valuation of certain of the Company's assets in a form acceptable to its auditors.
